Instructions to the School

Consent must be obtained when a request for SAAs are submitted electronically (via SSD Online) through school documentation consistent with district policy. This Consent Form may be used as an alternate method to obtain consent. Consent shall be retained by the school. This form or alternative evidence of consent does not need to be submitted to College Board. When submitting a request for SAA(s), the school's SSD Coordinator will be asked to verify that a signed Consent Form is on file at the school.

Required Student Data for Requests

College Board requires the following demographic data for all SAA requests: name, date of birth, expected high school graduation date, gender, current school, and student mailing address. In addition, the school is asked to provide the following required information regarding the student:

- Intended College Board tests
- Confirmation that the school has obtained parental consent to submit a request for SAA(s)
- Identification of SAA(s) being requested
