Funding cuts at the US Department of Education

We are aware of and following the <u>news of funding cuts</u> at the US Department of Education (USDE). While we have not received further information or guidance from the USDE, multiple news outlets have reported that reductions were focused on the Institute of Education Sciences. USDE spokesperson Madison Biedermann has said that the cuts will not affect the NAEP or the College Scorecard.
